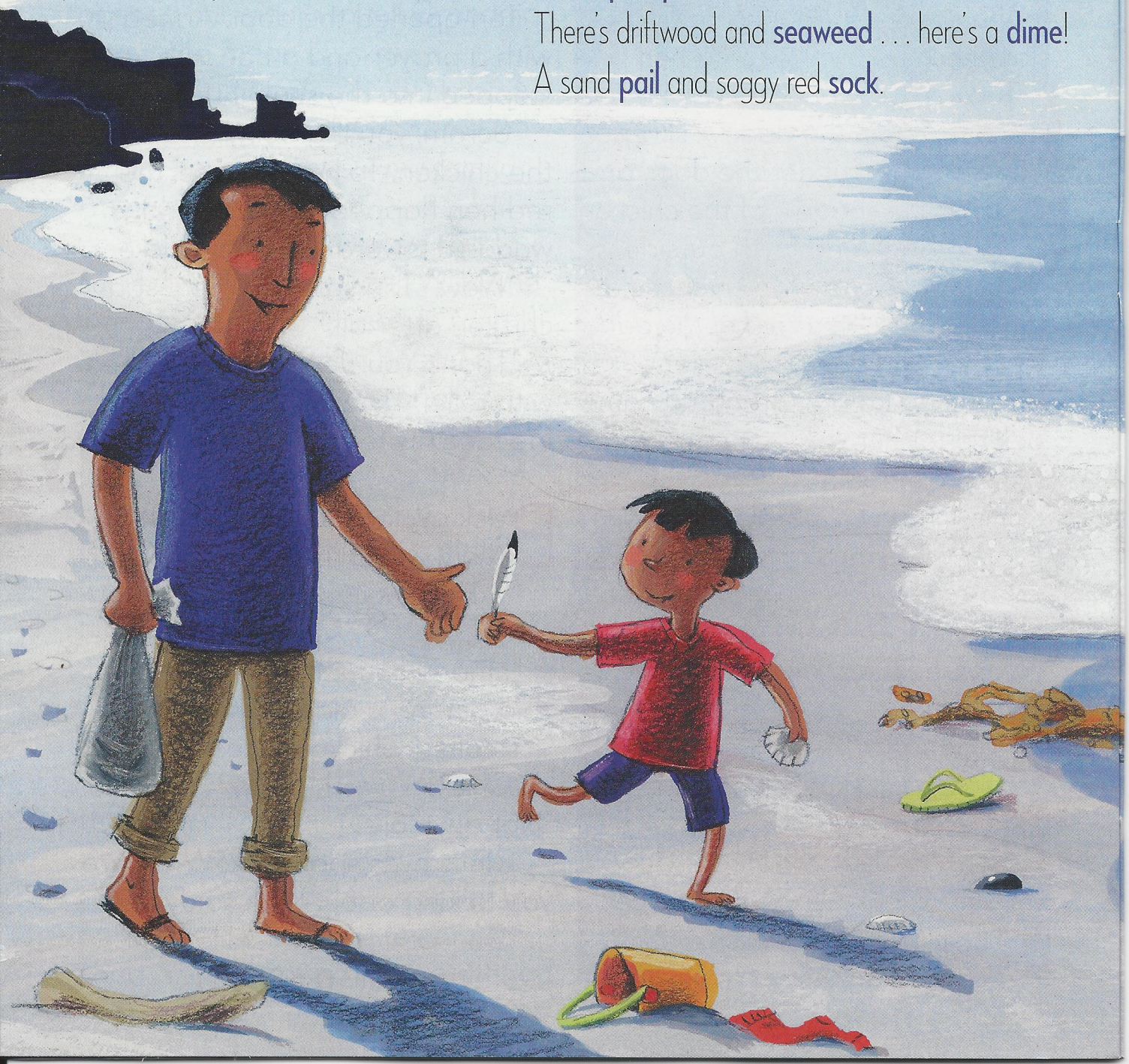


Beach Hunt
